Call for Roundtable Statements:

“Britain after the Referendum”

On the occasion of the 2015 Britain and the World Conference, which will take place in Austin, Texas (USA) between 2 April and 4 April 2015, the British Scholar Society is organizing a roundtable about “Britain after the Referendum”. Featuring, ideally, five different speakers representing a wide variety of views, the roundtable will discuss the consequences of the recent referendum on Scottish independence for the entire United Kingdom and its role in Europe and in the wider world. Placing contemporary constitutional developments and the various nationalisms co-existing within the United Kingdom into historical perspective, the discussion will try to assess whether British history has reached a turning point with the referendum.
